EXC 794-25-28 (6/1/93-6/1/94), EXC 763-64-82 (6/1/94-6/1/95), EXC 878-41-36 (6/1/95-6/1/96), EXC 878-11-12 (6/1/96-6/1/97), EXC 180-36-68 (6/1/97-6/1/98), and EXC 299-60-14 (6/1/98-6/1/99, cancelled as of 9/1/98). Under the settlement, the APG Debtors, Harbison-Walker Refractories, Ltd., and P.T. Harbison-Walker, on their own behalf and on behalf of their respective parents, successors, predecessors, past or present subsidiaries, and assigns, further released all rights to coverage under any other known or unknown liability insurance policies ever issued to them by GAIC, ANFIC, and their parents, subsidiaries and affiliates, with the exception of the Agricultural Insurance Company policies described above
